Update on our missionary Roberta Edwards and the Sonlight Children's Home in Port-au-Prince, Haiti (Thursday Jan. 14th) Taken from Estes church of Christ in Henderson TN website.

Thank you all for your concern and prayers concerning our missionary in Haiti, Roberta Edwards, and her work with the Sonlight Children's Home and Santo Nutrition Center. Here's a summary of the situation as it currently stands: Roberta was out of the country at the time of the earthquake, visiting with her parents. She is trying desperately to get back to Haiti. We have booked her on a flight to Miami from Belize Thursday and have managed to get her on a flight to Port-au-Prince on Friday morning. This is top priority for us – getting Roberta back to Haiti. Meanwhile, Josh Wyatt, from Memphis, TN, a regular part of our mission trips to Haiti, landed in the Dominican Republic today and is trying now to reach Roberta's kids over land. Hopefully he will be with them Thursday. The kids all know Josh and he will be a huge help and comfort to them. Roberta's house is still standing, and we have a report that our recently-purchased guesthouse is also still standing. Part of the guesthouse security wall has fallen, as has part of the wall surrounding Roberta's house. A part of an interior wall in Roberta's compound fell and killed one of Roberta's foster children, a teenage boy named Nicky. He was the only casualty at the Sonlight Children's home. The other children are safe and are being cared for by Thomas and Roberta's other older children. The children have food in the compound and some fuel for a generator. They are only able to contact us via email at this point. Hopefully the generator fuel will last until Josh and Roberta get there.

How can you help? Right now we are still evaluating the needs in Haiti, waiting for information. We already have bank accounts in place and ways to send money to Roberta so that is a blessing. We are collecting funds here and will send them to Roberta as she needs them. In the past, we have used money contributed for relief efforts to buy food and other basic supplies and we have distributed them through the local churches with Roberta facilitating. We hope to be able to do the same this time, although we are still evaluating the remaining infrastructure and are trying to find out information from the local preachers.

If you would like to make a monetary donation, you may send it to Estes Church of Christ, P. O. Box 191, Henderson, TN 38340. Please mark "Haiti Relief Effort" in the memo field. As we find out more information, there may be other needs you can help with, such as medical or food supplies or other items. We will wait until Roberta has had time to evaluate the situation fully before we plan to send people to Haiti to help with clean-up and re-building. We will post any needs that we have on this website. Thank you for your interest and your prayers. Taken from Estes church of Christ in Henderson TN website. Roberta was featured on this month's Christian Woman magazine, with a three page article about her work in Haiti, published before the earthquake.
